The only thing we really do is the Thursday night net

The ZOOM classes are just Earl and I presenting

No one uses the 145.47 repeater much anymore--it's quiet

Earl went around the ZOOM ROOM and asked each person what they thought.

I was going to post each person's comments but they are all pretty much the same:

- 1, We enjoy each other's company on Thursday nights and would hate to see that go away
2. Some of us long timers loved the TCRA club--it's been around us for a LONG time
3. Members have learned a lot about ham radio from other club members

4. AK folks say they are too new to the club to really voice an opinion
5. AK folks say they are too far away to perform club officer duties
6. AK folks say they would love to keep the Thursdays together
7. Steve stepped forward and said he would become an officer if we helped him
 - 7-a. Steve also volunteered Tom who also volunteered to be part of the officers
8. It would have been nice to have Walt present to hear what he has to say
9. Everyone understands we don't want to kill this off but it does make sense
10. Paul can keep the web-site running---at no cost to us or him
11. Paul said we shouldn't give club \$\$\$ to individuals, or it should be ham radio related

Everyone pretty much agree it's not really worth keeping the TCRA club going---but we should come up with a plan to keep meeting on a regular basis

Some idea's going forward:

1. Take club money and pay everyone's dues for 1 year in the Chippewa Club W9CVA
 - 1a The Chippewa Club would welcome us in no problem--they already discussed this
 - 2a A big gaggle of us TCRA members are already W9CVA members
 - 3a Chippewa Club said we could use the 147.345 machine for our Thursday nets
 - 3a-1 The 147.345 is on the same hill as 145.47 and its coverage is the same
 - 3a-2 we would be able to hook up ALSTAR to the 345 for the AK folks
 - 4a The Chippewa group has monthly 1st Tuesday of the month meetings
 - 4a-1 Their meetings are also ZOOM so the AK folks and far away people could partake
 - 4a-2 Their meetings usually have a great guest speaker or meeting topic
 - 5a The chippewa Club dues run March to March---so keep TCRA alive until March
 - 6a w9cva.org is the chippewa club web-page---snoop around
2. Take the rest of the club money and do
 - 2a put toward a high school student scholarship if they get a ham license
 - 2b put toward other clubs to help them
 - 3c at the very last meeting have a bunch of HRO gift certificates to random draw
 - 3d pay each member 1 year dues into a club of their choice
3. Pay Walt a one last sum of \$120 for the 2026 year

We don't want this move to stop members from not joining other clubs

1. Members said they would follow the group if we all went to 1 other club
2. Some members could join the Barron group---it would be closer for them
3. What I'm trying to say is----PLEASE join another group if we fold

Going forward

1. The club officers will meet in Early January to discuss these options and the money
2. The January 8th ZOOM club meeting we will take a vote to STAY or DROP the club

9PM ZOOM meeting cut us off for the 4th time---so we unofficially adjourned
